Eligibility

1. The CDU GMS is awarded at the discretion of the University to international students who are enrolled in full-time award study at CDU.
2. The CDU GMS is available for students commencing study in their first course (or suite of packaged courses) at CDU in 2027. Students may be considered eligible if they are returning students who have completed their course and are enrolling in a higher-level course at CDU.
3. The CDU GMS is only available to students applying for CDU TAFE, Undergraduate, Postgraduate (Coursework), and Higher Degree by Research courses.
4. The CDU GMS is only available to international students who are studying on a student visa or other eligible visa.
5. Courses exempt from the GMS in 2027 are listed in the table below.

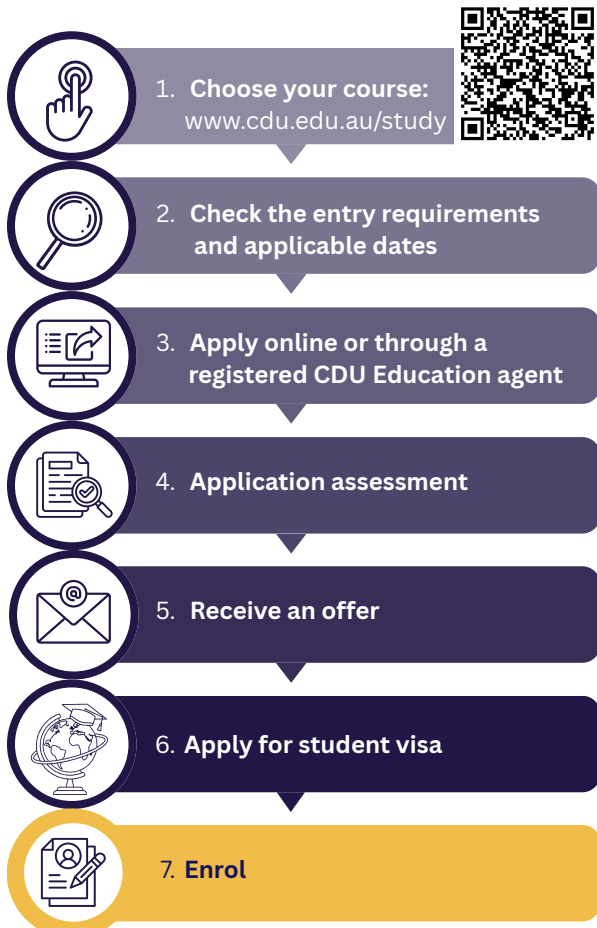
