Our campuses

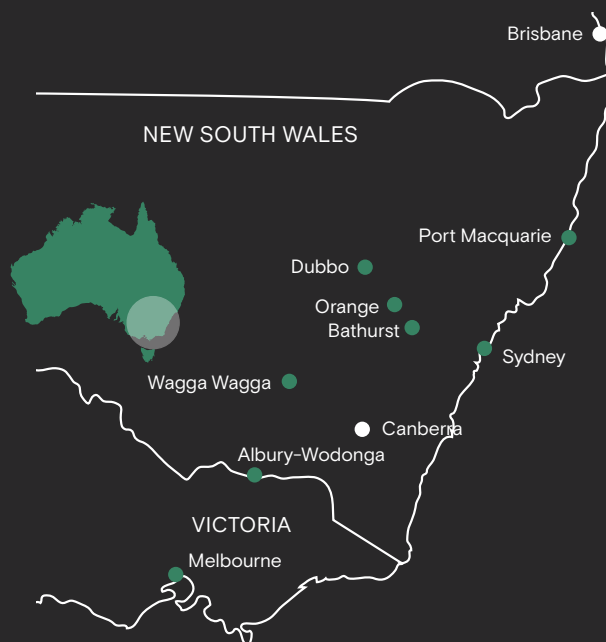
At Charles Sturt, we're geographically gifted.
