

Massey International Study Grants 2027

Terms and Conditions

1. Value of the Study grant

Eligible students will receive a study grant of NZD \$15,000 towards tuition fees for an eligible Bachelor's programme, or a study grant of NZD \$10,000 towards tuition fees for an eligible Master's programme, commencing in the 2027 academic year.

1.2 The study grant applies only to tuition fees and has no cash value.

1.3 The study grant cannot be transferred, exchanged, deferred or redeemed for any alternative benefit.

2. Eligibility

2.1 To be eligible, students must:

- be an international student. This study grant is not open to citizens or permanent residents of Australia or New Zealand.
- apply for and receive an offer of admission to an eligible Bachelor's or Master's qualification at Massey University.
- study on campus at one of our campuses in New Zealand.
- commence study in Semester 1 or Semester 2 of the 2027 academic year.
- meet all university admission requirements, including any programme-specific requirements.

2.2 Students who have received fully funded government scholarships are not eligible for the study grant. (e.g. Fed Aid, SACM, Manaaki or TSLs)

2.3 Applicants already enrolled in a Massey University partner institution's TNE, articulation programme or who have received recognition of prior learning (RPL) are not eligible for this study grant.

2.4 Massey University reserves the right to request information necessary to confirm eligibility.

3. Eligible Programmes

3.1 The study grant is available for selected Bachelor's and Master's Programmes offered by Massey University as listed below.

3.2 Massey University reserves the sole right to determine programme eligibility.

4. Application of the study grant

4.1 Students are not required to make a separate application for the study grant.

4.2 Eligibility will be confirmed when the student meets the entry requirements for the specific programme via an offer of place.

4.3 The study grant will be applied directly to the student's offer of place by way of a reduction in the tuition fees payable.

5. Withdrawal from Study

5.1 Students who withdraw from study before the relevant University census date may have the study grant cancelled.

5.2 If a recipient withdraws from their programme or reduces their enrolment below full-time status during the 2027 academic year, the study grant may be adjusted or prorated in accordance with the university's fees and refund policies.

5.3 Any fee adjustments will be managed in accordance with Massey University's standard fee refund and fee appeals processes.

5.4 No cash payment, refund or transfer of value will be made in respect of any unused portion of the study grant.

6. General Conditions

6.1 The study grant is available only for full-time study undertaken during the 2027 academic year. If you commence study in Semester 2, then the grant will apply to Semester 2, 2027 and Semester 1, 2028.

6.2 The study grant is available only to students at the offer stage and cannot be applied to students who are already enrolled.

- 6.3 Recipients must maintain full-time enrolment (120 credits) in the same eligible programme throughout the academic year (Semester 1 and Semester 2, 2027). Students commencing their studies in Semester 2 must remain enrolled full-time in the same eligible programme for Semester 2, 2027 and Semester 1, 2028. Failure to maintain the required enrolment may result in the scholarship being reduced, withdrawn, or adjusted on a pro rata basis.
- 6.4 Massey University may amend, suspend or withdraw the study grant where necessary.
- 6.5 The study grant cannot be used in conjunction with any other scholarships or fee reductions offered by the University.
- 6.6 All decisions regarding eligibility, administration and interpretation of these Terms and Conditions are final.
